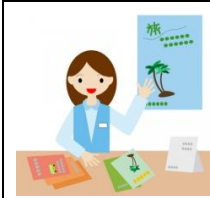
Local Resident (Grandma Yuki)

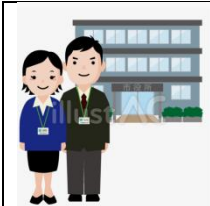

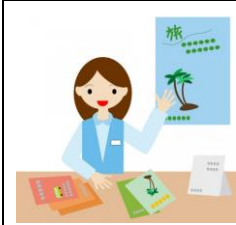
